





Learn to Fish Like the Natives of the Amazon

Immerse yourself in a unique cultural experience with our Traditional Fishing activity. Guided by local experts, you will learn the ancestral fishing techniques used by Kichwa communities, such as casting nets (atarraya) and traditional hooks.

River fishing with the atarraya takes place at dusk, and you should be prepared to get completely wet. Depending on the season and the catch, the fish will be released to preserve the ecosystem, cooked on-site over a campfire (if weather conditions allow), or prepared at the lodge, if possible.

- Visit a Kichwa community, enjoy a traditional meal, and experience their way of life
- Conclude the adventure with a canoe ride along the Arajuno River

- Camera and binoculars for wildlife observation
